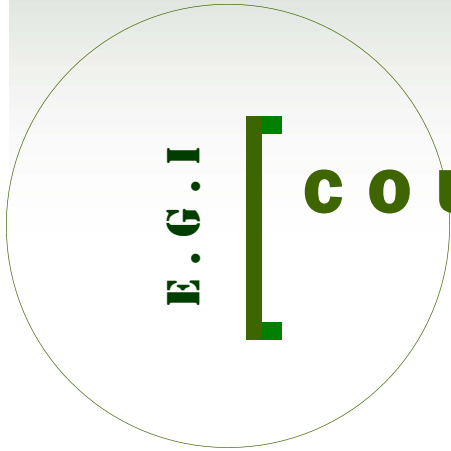

## **ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS**

To be considered for admission, each applicant must complete an internship application, including the testimony essay. Applicants will take a test to determine their spiritual gifts. They will also need to obtain two recommendations: one from their Pastor and one from their parents.

## **ATTENDANCE POLICY**

Students are expected to arrive at least ten minutes early for all classes and meetings. If for any reason a student is unable to attend any daily sessions, he/she is required to contact any of the staff members.

Tardy Policy:

- Description: Arriving to class after the designated start times, or not being prepared, quiet and ready to work at the designated start times for classes.
- Any tardiness to any class or activity will result in two hours of discipline work on their day off.

# **DISCIPLINE/EXPULSION POLICY**

Late assignments will result in two hours of discipline per assignment per day.

Any use of drugs or alcohol will result in expulsion with no refund of tuition.

Any use of weapons will result in expulsion.

## **GRADING POLICY**

Grading is based on a Pass/Fail system. Students are required to attend and participate in order to graduate.

Grading for the Biblical Studies is as follows:

25% Class attendance/video

25% Bible reading assignment

25% Class participation

25% Class notes

# **CLASS SCHEDULE**

Elijah Generation operates on a two week rotating schedule.

The first week's activities include praying at the Trinity Broadcasting Network studios, as well as core subjects such as Biblical Studies, and Professional Development.

The second week's schedule also includes going to St. Vincent De Paul's Soup Kitchen, learning human videos, evangelism, etc.

Our experience finds integrating a variety of learning and fun activities maximizes the student's learning potential.

The morning/afternoon schedule mainly consists of classroom time, while the evening also includes classes that incorporate hands-on practical application of classroom concepts.

## Biblical Studies

## Professional Development

This course initials how to begin and maintain a business. The students learn about real estate investing and how to protect their assets.

In this class, the students do various activities for physical health as well as promoting team building skills, i.e. volleyball, soccer, climbing mountains, etc.

## Scripture Memorization

This course requires the students to memorize 10 scriptures a week. A test is given at the end of every week.

## Family Life Groups

Spirit Life Church's Family Life Groups are a weekly part of the students routine. These groups give the students time to fellowship with peers as well as learn how to Pastor the sheep.

## Evangelism

The student receives hands-on training on how to spread the Word of God. Every week they go to a different location in the city and talk to people about Jesus.

## Community Service

The students work at St. Vincent De Paul soup kitchen. They help serve in the warehouse folding clothes, cooking in the kitchen or serving the homeless!

## Group Studies

Koinonia Groups is a time for the students to get together in smaller groups for a time of reading and fellowship. This time is also used as an opportunity to catch up on missing assignments.

## Follow-up Ministry

Students develop ministerial skills as they work with the Follow-up ministry by calling and visiting people who have visited Spirit Life Church.

## Parenting Workshop

This course helps the student learn relational concepts and communication skills to improve relationships with parents as well as prepare for the future as parents.
